## **Regehr rockets ahead of McLennan**

Arriving for a post-game interview with a throng of reporters, Robyn Regehr pleaded, "Easy with the jokes."

Guess he wouldn't want to be called the Man of the Century.

That's how long it felt since the Calgary Flames defenceman last scored a regular-season goal.

It's not that bad but it had been 100 goal-free games since he last lit the lamp, April 4, 2002, against the Minnesota Wild, to be exact.

That drought was finally quenched at 8:48 of the second period in last night's 4-4 draw with the Vancouver Canucks when Regehr wristed a point shot past Dan Cloutier and just inside the far post.

"I knew I was closing in on triple digits a little while ago, so I had to get it done. It felt really good," he said. "Like I said earlier this year, I'd really stopped keeping track every day after it gets that high."

Still, he was feeling a bit of heat over not having tallied for more than a full season, especially since he's a regular on the powerplay.
